**NEU Strike:** Repeat of the message already sent out.

I am sure you will have heard on the news or in social media that the National Education Union have announced an unexpected strike on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July**. As with any strike, unfortunately there is always disruption to some classes within school. I have been updated and Governors and I are now able to share details with you.
