# Culture of Learning Walk:

When anyone completes a Learning Walk, here are the things we look out for:

What can you **see** and **hear** that adds knowledge of teaching and learning taking place across the school?

- ✓ Does the environment feel welcoming and have a sense of 'learning purpose'?
- ✓ Are children engaged in their learning? Are they interacting well with each other / teacher / TA? Do they engage with in conversation?
- ✓ Is the environment safe and welcoming?
- ✓ Are working walls used to teach and other boards used to celebrate?
- ✓ How does behaviour and safety 'feel' as you walk around school? Are any issues, are they dealt with appropriately?
- ✓ Are Learners Who Need More having their work / experience adapted to ensure Northway is inclusive?

The key words we have are: Purpose Belonging Behaviour Engagement Teaching Sequence. All this contributes to assessing whether All Learners are All Valued and enabled to All Achieve.
